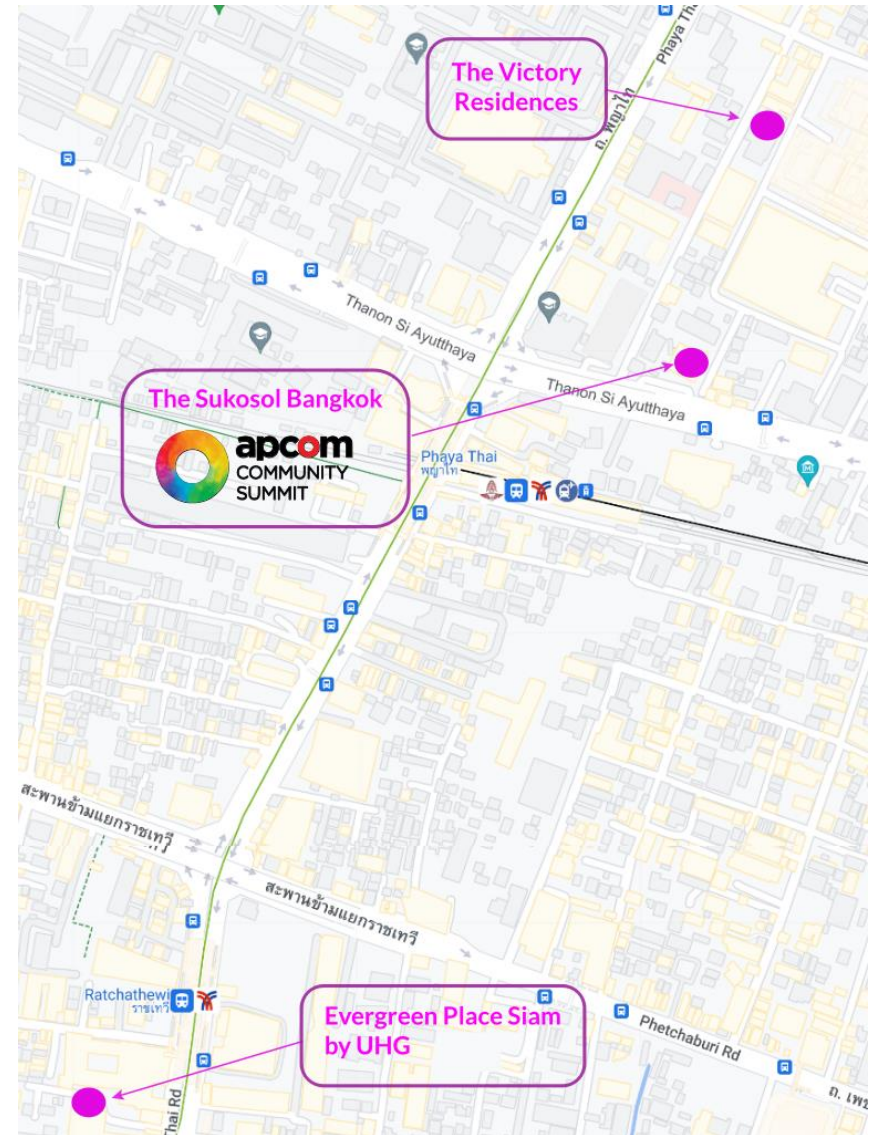
This accommodation is 350m away from the Summit Venue, and a walking distance of 5 minutes
